This letter is in response to your request for information as to whether various products contain "conflict minerals," which the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission has defined as gold, columbite-tantalite (coltan), cassiterite, wolframite, or their derivatives (tin, tantalum, or tungsten).

Ohio Semitronics (OSI) is dedicated to complying with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act regarding conflict minerals. OSI has identified all production uses of conflict mineral and has conducted a Reasonable Country of Origin Inquiry (RCOI) on those materials. OSI has queried the suppliers and has every reason to believe the material being utilized in production of our products did not originate from any of the restricted countries or from sources of scrap or recycled minerals.

OSI will maintain the records used to make the determination whether OSI is in compliance with Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act regarding conflict minerals.
